Re: Show Cause – WBO Female Welterweight Participant Jessica McCaskill

Dear Mr. Hearn:

Please be advised that on Monday, August 1, 2022, the WBO confirmed receipt of email correspondence by Mr. Tom Dallas, on behalf of Matchroom Boxing requesting sanction approval for the Vacant WBO Female Jr. Welterweight Championship (140 lb) between Jessica McCaskill and Chantelle Cameron.

Accordingly, on Wednesday, November 2, 2022, the WBO main offices issued via email correspondence to Matchroom's Legal Counsel Mr. Jai Singh the official sanction letter and applicable promoter receipt for the Cameron/McCaskill bout. The foregoing bout was sanctioned subject to specific provisions considering that McCaskill reigned as the Undisputed WBO/WBA/WBC/IBF Welterweight Champion and requested authorization to contest for the Vacant WBO Jr. Welterweight Championship¹.

Consequently, the McCaskill/Cameron bout was sanctioned subject to (i) if McCaskill was successful against Cameron, she would have 10-days after the bout to determine which weight division (140 lb or 147 lb) be retained; and (ii) if McCaskill was not successful against Cameron, her WBO Welterweight Championship Title would be declared "Vacant" Ipso Facto". These conditions were agreed and accepted by Matchroom Boxing. See, Section 5 (e) of the WBO Regulations of World Championship Contests

On Saturday, November 5, 2022, Chantelle Cameron defeated Jessica McCaskill via unanimous decision (UD). The bout was held at the Etihad Arena, Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates. In light of McCaskill's defeat, the provision referenced in the official sanction letter triggered accordingly with immediate effect.

Therefore, based on the foregoing, Ms. McCaskill is hereby ordered to show cause within the next 10-days upon issuance of this notice as to why this Committee should not declare the WBO Female Welterweight Championship "Vacant" pursuant to the provisions imposed by the WBO per the official sanction letter referenced herein.
